

Coming from Evreux and Nonancourt (North and West)

From Nonancourt, take N12 towards Dreux and exit left in the roundabout indicating "St Germain sur Avre". Pass through the charming village of St Rémy, still following the signs for "St Germain sur Avre" (going towards the church).

When you leave St Rémy (after having gone past the church and the "Gendarmerie"), you will cross the railroad tracks before coming to the village St Germain and a crossing. Turn left, towards "Mesnil sur l'Estrée", and cross a couple of bridges over the river Avre. You find us in Trussy Farm, to the right just after the bridges, with the white iron gate.

Coming from Paris (East) or Chartres (South)

Drive out of Dreux on the N12 following the signs for Evreux. After 5.5 kilometers, you will arrive at a TOTAL station called "Aire du Bois de Vert" . Drive off the N12 and cross the TOTAL station, turn right onto the D312.9 towards "St Germain sur Avre".

Arriving at the T after 1.5 km of winding road, turn left towards St Germain sur Avre (D152). After 1.6 km, at the first stop sign, turn right, cross the 3 bridges. Trussy is the property on the right, just past the bridges, with the large white iron gate.


